

2015 ASEAN-JAPAN Energy Efficiency and Conservation Symposium on Standard and Labeling Policy in Lao PDR took place on 15 Dec. 2015 in the presence of Lao's MEM Deputy Director General, and Mr.J.Sogawa (MD, ECCJ).

In the ASEAN member states, where significant increase in power consumption has been observed, importance of the energy-efficiency standards and labeling (S&L) system in the field of sumconer electronics, as a part of energy conservation measures in civilian sector, has been recognized.

Under such circumstances, in Laos where the S&L system is yet to be established, the “2015 ASEAN-JAPAN Energy Efficiency and Conservation Symposium on Standard and Labeling Policy in Vientiane” took place on December 15, 2015 at the Mercure Vientiane Hotel in Vientiane.
