ECCJ Implemented Workshop Aiming at Establishment of Energy Conservation Act in Myanmar

[Project Summary]

Entrusted to promote Energy Conservation in executing projects of Rationalization of International Energy Use and the Capacity Building by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI), the Energy Conservation Center, Japan (ECCJ) implemented the 2nd workshop during 2 days from December 20 to December 21, 2016 at the Ministry of Industry in Nay Pyi Taw aiming at establishment of Energy Conservation Act.







The Energy Conservation Center, Japan have been continuing to support the Ministry of Industry of Myanmar which is preparing to establish Energy Conservation Act.

This time, the ECCJ implemented a follow-up research to confirm the progress made after the first dispatch in August, provision of information on the transport sector to be newly incorporated, and introduction of successful cases of the industry and building sector, which was requested from Myanmar.

As for progress after August, it was confirmed that concept of designated business operators to be selected, qualified energy manager system and S&L system was under good preperation. Based on the concept, the Ministry of Industry established a Working Committee (W/C) to study details with governmental bodies and organizations, 18 organizations in total, which are to be involved in the implementation.

The workshop participants of this time were members of this W/C and they discussed legal measures that may become necessary hereafter for each sector. It was a kind of kick-off meeting of the W/C, therefore ECCJ is going to provide support hereafter.
