## Background

The transport sector is considered one of the most energy intensive sectors in ASEAN. The APAEC Phase II (2021-2025) specifies that the EE&C-SSN will explore EE opportunities in the transport sector, including smart transport, and will conduct information sharing on EE policy and measures, including fuel-efficiency standards and high-efficient vehicles promotion and capacity building in collaboration with the dialogue partners and international organizations and relevant stakeholders.
