Energy Manager Training Courses (EMTC) by MAESCO

2.Purpose of measure

MAESCO, the abbreviation for 'Malaysian Association of Energy Service Companies' established in 2000, is a society registered with the Registrar of Societies. Amongst its constitutional objective is to collaborate with the Government of Malaysia and its agencies towards the promotional of Energy Efficiency practices and development of Energy Service Companies (ESCOs) as a recognised business model.
