

1.Name of measure

Warm Up New Zealand: Heat Smart (WUNZ:HS) and Warm Up New Zealand: Healthy Homes (HH). (These programmes are New Zealand's insulation programmes and were previously known as 'ENERGYWISE Homes'.)

2.Purpose of measure

EECA's goal is for more New Zealanders to enjoy the benefits of homes that are warm, dry and more energy efficient. The residential programmes have encompassed a number of initiatives: information tools and campaigns, and two significant insulation programmes – Warm Up New Zealand:Heat Smart and Warm Up New Zealand:Healthy Homes. WUNZ:HH has the target of insulating 46,000 low-income households between 2013/14 and 2015/16 by providing Government grant funding for insulation. It builds on Warm Up New Zealand: Heat Smart, which insulated 241,000 houses between 2009/10 and 2013/14.

3.Target sector (transport, building, manufacturing, etc.)

Homes (provision of insulation and heating devices)

4.Funds and budget for the measure

A mixture of the agency's own resources, Government grant funding and private and third party resources.

5.Method for measuring the effect of the measure

(energy consumption reduction, energy cost reduction, etc.)

Programme level monitoring and reporting of results to the Minister of Energy and Resources, the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment, and EECA's Board.

6.Results of measures

Over 281,000 homes insulated to date under first the now finished WUNZ:HS, and secondly the current WUNZ:HH. WUNZ:HH programme is on track to achieve its target of 46,000.
