1. Name of measure

Philippine National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Program
(Started in 2004)

2. Purpose of measure

To make energy efficiency and conservation (EE&C) a way of life.

- To improve utilization of all users through energy efficiency and conservation programs.
- To achieve an average annual energy savings of 23 MMBFOE (Million Barrels of Fuel Oil Equivalent) and 5.086 Gg CO₂ equivalent emissions avoidance.

\$ 778,044 approved 2008 budget
