1.Name of measure

Energy Conservation Act (Chapter 92C)

2.Purpose of measure

An Act to mandate energy efficiency requirements and energy management practices to promote energy conservation, improve energy efficiency and reduce environmental impact, and to make consequential and related amendments to certain other written laws.

3.Outline and applicable sectors (transport, buildings, manufacturing, etc.)

Under the Energy Conservation Act, energy intensive users in industrial and transport sectors consuming 54 TJ of energy or more each year and in at least 2 of the 3 preceding calendar years are required to appoint at least one energy manager, monitor and report their energy use and greenhouse gas emissions (GHG), and submit energy efficiency improvement plans on an annual basis.

Compliance with mandatory energy management requirements.

All regulated companies under the ECA have appointed at least one energy manager and submitted their first energy use reports and energy efficiency improvement plans in 2013.
