1.Name of measure

Public Sector Taking the Lead in Environmental Sustainability (PSTLES)

2.Purpose of measure

To encourage public sector agencies to put in place organisational processes for resource management, and implement environmental sustainability measures that encompass energy efficiency, water efficiency and recycling.

3. Target sector (transport, building, manufacturing, etc.)

Public Sector

4.Funds and budget for the measure

Administrative costs only

5.Method for measuring the effect of the measure

(energy consumption reduction, energy cost reduction, etc.)

1) Each Ministry is required to set energy reduction target for FY2020 and develop resource management plan to meet the targets.

2) Public sector agencies are also encouraged to adopt the Guaranteed Energy Savings Performance (GESP) contracting model when undertaking building retrofit projects.

6.Results of measures

1) Public sector's energy reduction target would only be ready in Dec 2015.

2) As of March 2015, 18 large building owners have called GESP contracts for their building retrofit works. 4 GESP projects are in the energy audit stage, while 14 building owners have implemented or are implementing the identified energy efficiency improvement measures. On average, these GESP contracts help building owners save 15% of their total electricity use, enabling public sector to save a total of \$6million per year.

7.Future tasks

1) Once the Public Sector's energy reduction target is set, efforts would be made to track the Public Sector's progress in achieving the target.

2) It is an ongoing task to encourage more public sector building owners to adopt the GESP contracting model when undertaking building retrofit projects.
