To enhance the professionalism and quality of services offered by ESCOs

The accreditation is open to any ESCO established in Singapore who wishes to be accredited in the provision of energy auditing services and implementation of energy efficiency and conservation projects for buildings and facilities.

Accreditation is differentiated according to the level of experience of the ESCO and the types of systems expertise the ESCO possesses.
