

1.Name of measure

Direct Subsidy

2.Purpose of measure

Promote energy efficiency by subsidizing 20% (or 30% for Small/Medium-sized Enterprise) of capital investment in high-efficiency equipment. SMEs are defined as factories and buildings that are not classified as designated buildings/factories.

3.Outline and applicable sectors (transport, buildings, manufacturing, etc.)

Designated buildings/factories and SMEs

4.Financial resources and budget allocation of measures

A total of 500,000,000 Baht has been allocated for this measure in 2015. Each project is eligible for a subsidy of no larger than 3,000,000 baht.

5.Method to measure effects of measures (reduction in energy consumption and energy cost, etc.)

Amount of projects, approximated energy saving, total investment in energy efficient technologies

6.Results of measures

Since the start of this measure in 2010, a total of 1,462 projects have been approved, resulting in an energy saving of 26.90 ktoe/year. The total investment created by this measure is 2.1 billion Baht.

7.Future tasks

Increase the amount of funding available for the measure to 500 million Baht.
